

EWDTS Anya Pierce Young Scientist Award 2025

The EWDTS continue to promote innovation from young scientists in the field of workplace drug and alcohol testing. The challenge is to submit fresh ideas, relevant to the industry, and presented in an easily accessible format. The award is held in the name of Anya Pierce, a former EWDTS Board Member who has always encouraged the young researchers to pursue their careers and will be remembered for her enthusiasm and dedication to science, and forensic toxicology in particular.

- Applications open to scientists under 35 (at the time of submission deadline).
- Submissions can be made from 1st of February 2025.
- Submission close date is the 1st of March 2025.
- Submissions must be sent to <u>conference@ewdts.org</u>

All submissions must be made in the form of an abstract for a poster presentation, with a maximum of 500 words. In addition, all submissions must be accompanied by a short bio.

The EWDTS Board will score the submissions and decide the winner.

The winner will be announced on the 15th of March 2025.

To accept the prize, the winning submission will need to deliver a 10-minute oral presentation (in person) at the EWDTS conference in Barcelona on 11th April 2025.

The winner will receive €500.00 in cash, 2 nights free accommodation at the EWDTS conference hotel, and free entrance to the EWDTS conference.

Note: All applicants will need to provide an informed professional reference and may be asked to prove their age at the time of the submission deadline.
